You have made an investment that we are confident will improve your listening experience and bring you joy for many years to come.

How it works

All power and speaker cables carry high currents that generate strong electromagnetic fields. These fields can interact with nearby components and cables, introducing subtle timing errors, noise, and a loss of coherence in the system.

Magneus Power passively shapes the electromagnetic environment around these high-current cables. By calming field behaviour without touching the signal, it reduces unwanted interactions that can compromise clarity, low-frequency control, and spatial definition. The result is a more grounded, balanced, and composed presentation with enhanced resolution and a deeper connection to the music.

Getting started

1. Choose where you intend to place Magneus Power. Optimally, this would be between your power outlet and power distribution (1). If not using power distribution, the next most effective place is between your power outlet and integrated or power amplifier (2). Finally, Magneus Power can also be placed between your amplifier and speakers (3). In this use case, one unit per channel is optimal but it is also possible to run both channels through a single Magneus Power.

Whatever your set-up, we recommend trialling placements to find what works best for your system.

2. Disconnect your cable(s) from either termination.
3. Feed the cable(s) through the opening of the Magneus Power.
4. Reconnect your cable(s).
5. Listen to some music and enjoy the improved soundstage and microdetails.
